## Part 2: Responsibilities for health and safety

Overall and final responsibility for health and safety:

**Club Chair** 

Day-to-day responsibility for ensuring this policy is put into practice:

**Club Secretary** 

To ensure health and safety standards are maintained/improved, the following people have responsibility in the following areas:

Club Chair and Club Secretary – safety, risk assessments, consulting with club members, accidents and first aid.

Club Secretary – monitoring accident situations.

Head Coach – maintaining equipment, information, instruction and supervision, training.

All club members should:

- Co-operate with coaches and committee members on health and safety matters.
- Take reasonable care of their own health and safety; and
- Report all health and safety concerns to an appropriate person (as detailed above).

## Part 3: Arrangements for health and safety

## Risk assessment:

We will complete relevant risk assessments as required and take relevant action.

We will review risk assessments when club activities or conditions change.

#### Training:

We will provide adequate training for coaches to carry out their roles.

## Consultation:

We will consult with all club members routinely on health and safety matters as they arise and on an annual basis.
